Our guide to making secure passwords

Step	Instruction	Result
1	Think of a phrase, this could be a well known saying, a quote from your favourite book/play/movie or a lyric from a memorable song.	Once more unto the breach
2	Use the first letter from each word to create a series of letters.	Omutb
3	Exchange any words you can for numbers	1mutb
4	Add one or more special characters (!, '', ?, /, #, £ etc.)	1mutb!
5	Add the year	1mutb!2014
6	Associate it with a website (ie. Add "FB" for Facebook or "Amz" for Amazon)	1mutb!2014FB
You could also make it more distinctive, why not take the vowels/ consonants from the website's name?		"1mutb!aao Or "1mutb!mzn
